Directions and Parking

Salem Five, 210 Essex Street, Salem, MA 01970

From Route 1 North or I-93 North

Take Rt. 128N exit, to Exit 26 (Lowell St.) and follow directions from Rt.128, Exit 26 below.

From Boston - I-93N (30 Minutes)

Take I-93N to Exit 37A (I-95N) to Rt. 128N, Take exit 26 (Lowell St.) and follow directions from Rt.128, Exit 26 below.

From Maine/New Hampshire - I-95S or I-93S

Take I-95S (ME) or I-93S (NH) to Rt. 128N, Take Exit 26 (Lowell St.) and follow directions from Rt.128, Exit 26 below.

From Mass Pike - Rte. 90E

Take Rt. 90E to I-95N to Rt. 128N, Take Exit 26 (Lowell St.) and follow directions from Rt.128, Exit 26 below.

From Rockport/Gloucester - Rte. 128S

Take Rt. 128S to Exit 26 (Lowell St.) and follow directions from Rt.128, Exit 26 below.

From Rt. 128, Exit 26 (Lowell Street)

1. From Rt. 128S, turn left onto Lowell Street heading East for approximately 1.3 miles.
2. From Rt. 128N, turn right onto Lowell Street heading East for approximately 1.3 miles.
3. You will go through Peabody center, passing a large statue to your left.
4. Lowell Street will change to Main Street and then to Boston Street as you travel through Peabody center. Continue straight on these streets.
5. You will pass McDonald's on your right and then a Mobil gas station. Continue Straight.
6. Shortly after the Mobil gas station you will come to a set of lights (Dunkin Donuts is on your left.) At the set of lights, take left onto Bridge Street (Rt. 107) and follow for approx. 0.9 miles.
7. The Salem train station will be on your left. Stay left and continue through set of lights.
8. After set of lights take 2nd right onto St. Peter's Street. Follow straight.

Your parking options are:

1. From St. Peter's Street, take 1st right onto Federal Street and follow straight to the municipal parking lot. Ticket entrance will be on your left. From this parking lot walk across Church Street and follow straight through to the Essex Street pedestrian walkway.
2. From St. Peter's Street, take 2nd right on Church Street. You can access the metered parking lot entrance on your right. From this parking lot walk across Church Street and follow straight through to the Essex Street pedestrian walkway.
3. From St. Peter's Street, turn left. Take first right to enter the parking garage ticket entrance. From the garage take stairway or elevator down to the Mall level. Turn right and exit Mall near Peabody Essex Museum. Turn right on Essex Street pedestrian walkway to Salem Five. We are located next to CVS.
