

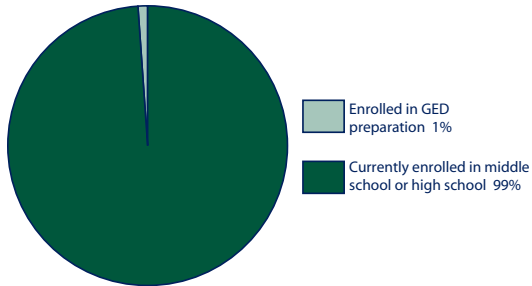

NUMBER OF YOUTH SERVED BY YOUTHWORKS IN 2008

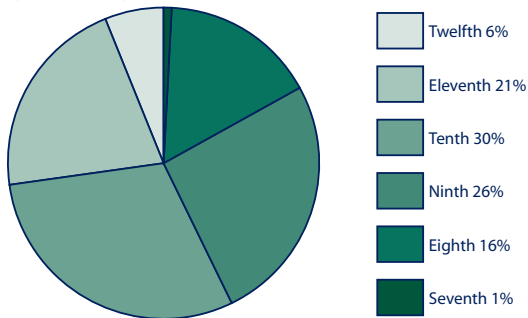

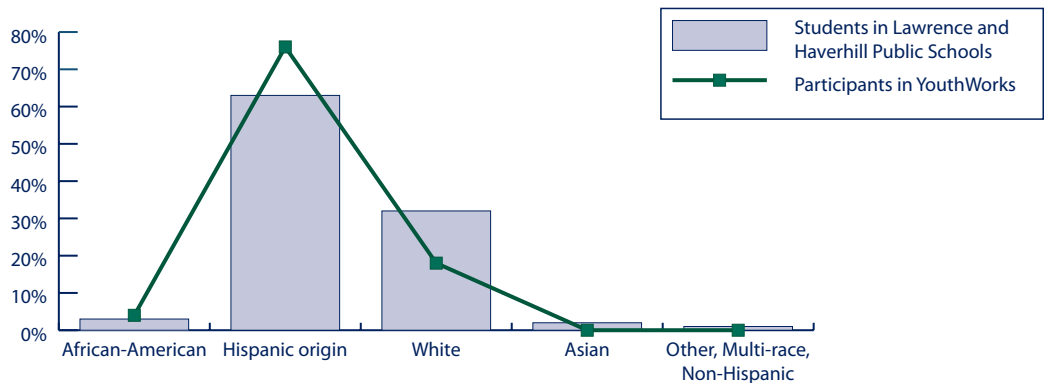
